Bismarck School Board candidates will answer questions posed by League members and the public beginning at 6:30 p.m. Burleigh County Sheriff candidates will appear at 7:30 p.m. Both forums can be viewed live on Cable Channel 12 or via web stream at www.freetv.org by clicking the “On Air” icon. Forums will be replayed in the weeks leading up to the June election.
