January: 900+ bills filed!

Jan-Feb: Public hearings and floor votes on bills

Feb 24th: House & Senate swap bills that passed

March: Public hearings and floor votes

April: End of Session

Good Bills that Passed

1) Require school board candidates to submit campaign finance reports

2) Require candidates to file with an email address

House Bills 1116 & 1257

> House Bill 1424

Bills That Failed

- Getting rid of mail-in voting
- Limiting drop boxes
- Limiting vote centers





Requiring Proof of Citizenship

- It's unnecessary
- It's discriminatory
- It opens the state up to costly litigation

House Bill 1431

- 15,000+ "permanent residents" cards on file
- 700+ people naturalized per year

Banning Ranked-Choice & Approval Voting

 It prevents communities from implementing their preferred voting method

House Bill 1273

- Compels plurality voting
- Fargo used approval voting in 2020 & 2022

Restricting Ballot Initiatives

 Will negatively impact citizen-led efforts to participate in the governance of our state

HCR 3031 SCR 4013

- More petition signatures required
- Requires majority of votes in majority of counties
- Has to pass primary AND general elections
